Adam Neal Horst, of Yates Center, Kansas, died Friday, December 9, 2016, in Bartlesville, Oklahoma, at the age of 92.

The oldest son of Dwight and Nellie Horst, Adam was raised on a small farm near Madison, Kansas, where he helped with the family dairy business before graduating from high school. He served in the navy in World War II after his first 2 years of college. An employee of Kansas Gas & Electric company for over 30 years he retired from that company in the early 80's, last being employed as a right-of-way agent.

Adam is preceded in death by his wife Doris (Fleming), parents, and brother Roger. He helped serve the Yates Center community, delivering meals on wheels, and held strong friendships with many in that area.
