Mr. Andrew Franklin "Babe" Bryant, 73, of Barnsdall, died at 12:53 A.M. on Thursday at the Jane Phillips Medical Center in Bartlesville.

Funeral services for Mr. Bryant were held at 2 P.M. on Monday, February 13, 2012 at the First Assembly of God Church with Rev. Phil Clements, Rev. Dennis Thrasher, and Rev. Arlis Thrasher officiating. Interment was in the Ethel Reece Cemetery at Barnsdall directed by the Stumpff Barnsdall Funeral Home.

Mr. Bryant was born at Pawhuska, Oklahoma on April 27, 1938 to Nathaniel Arlie and Helen Mae (Grimminger) Bryant. He grew up and received his education in Barnsdall and graduated in 1958 where he was a lifelong resident. He was married to Marion Horine at Barnsdall on October 12, 1961. They made their home in Barnsdall and he was employed with Petrolite/Bareco as a pumper until his retirement in 1996 with over 30 years of service. He was a member of the First Assembly of God Church where he

was active in teaching young men in the Royal Rangers. He was involved in the mowing and maintenance of the church facility. He has served in the U.S. Army Reserve and he enjoyed fishing, woodworking, was an avid birdwatcher, and spending time with his grandchildren.

Mr. Bryant is survived by his wife, Marion Bryant, four children, Mrs. Kay Pickup and husband Rodney of Jay, Oklahoma, Michael Don Bryant, Chance Bryant and wife Sayra of Barnsdall, and Glynis Brown of Barnsdall, two sisters, Wanda Mae Forbes and Betty Sue King, both of Barnsdall, and one sister-in-law, Donna Bryant of Pawhuska, 10 grandchildren, one great grandchild and numerous nieces & nephews and other relatives. He was preceded in death by his parents, one sister, Arlene Bryant in 1998, a brother Arlie Ray Bryant of 2009 and one grandson, Michael L. Boutwell in 2003.
