



## Anita Ann Coast

August 14, 1935 - September 6, 2021

Anita Ann Coast passed away on September 6, 2021, at the age of 86. She was born on August 14, 1935, in Bunker Hill, Kansas to Edward Claire Willson and Alice Rowena Graham Willson.

She attended grammar school in Bunker Hill, Kansas. She graduated from Tulsa Central High School in 1953.

She met Gerald Lee Coast at the Friends Church in Tulsa, Oklahoma. They married in 1953 while Gerald was on military leave and moved to Rapid City, South Dakota. It was here that they started their family with their first child Steven Lee Coast. After Gerald was discharged from the Army, they moved to Bartlesville, OK.
