Mr. Benne Joe Allen Sr., 82, of Dewey, died at 3:46 P.M. on Friday, July 24, 2020 at The Journey Home in Bartlesville.

Mr. Allen was born at Ramona, Oklahoma on October 5, 1937 the son of John Reed Allen and Hazel Lee (Odell) Allen. He grew up primarily in the Ochelata area and attended schools at Vera, Ramona and Ochelata. He was married to Dixie Faye Morrison at her parent's home in Ochelata on December 12, 1958. 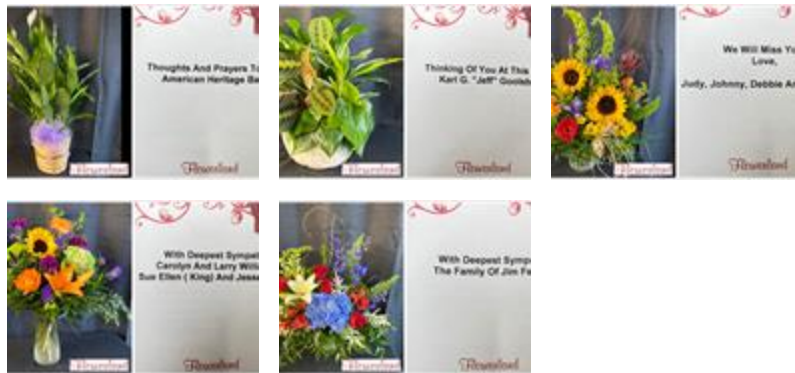
