Mrs. Beverly A. Loffer, 89, of Bartlesville, died at 6:53 A.M. Thursday, January 16, 2014.

She was married to Bill Eugene Loffer on November 30, 1944 at Coffeyville, Kansas, they met while Mr. Loffer was serving in the U.S. Army Air Corp and she was volunteering with the U.S.O. in Coffeyville. They made their home in various locations including Ft. Worth, Texas, California, and Independence, Kansas before moving to Bartlesville, Oklahoma in 1953. Mrs. Loffer was a member of the Daughters of the American Revolution, a founding member of the Good Shepherd Presbyterian Church and served as a volunteer at Jane Phillips Medical Center Emergency Room for close to

twenty years. Mrs. Loffer was head of the Good Shepherd Retirees Group for more than ten years. She enjoyed collecting antiques especially Pinocchio Dolls. She especially enjoyed visiting with family and grandchildren.
