Osment, Beverly Sue 71, passed away Friday, January 22, 2016 in Dewey, Oklahoma.

Beverly was born on October 18, 1944 In Wichita, Kansas to parents A.K. and Lorraine "Pat" (Ecklund) Osment.

Beverly moved from Wichita to Bartlesville in 1956. She graduated from College High in 1962. She then attended Bartlesville Business College, and later Tri-County Tech for medical training. Beverly worked in Tulsa at Cities Service Company and various small businesses in Bartlesville before taking a job at the Examiner Enterprise newspaper and then at Jane Phillips Medical Center business office. In the early 1990's Beverly returned to Tulsa to work for Neurological Associates of Tulsa and Family Medical Care in the Accounts Receivable department. Beverly became disabled in 2002, and returned to Bartlesville in 2005.

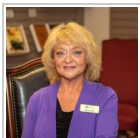

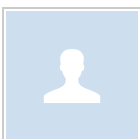
