Mrs. Billie Kaye McGrew, 79, of Bartlesville, went home to be with Jesus at 5 P.M. on Saturday, August 10, 2013 at the St. John Medical Center in Tulsa. Funeral services for Billie Kaye McGrew will be held at 2 P.M. on Wednesday, August 14, 2013 at Bartlesville Southern Baptist Church with Pastors Edgar Gordon of the Trinity Baptist Church and Paul Rummage of Bartlesville Southern Baptist Church officiating. Interment will be in the Sunnyside Cemetery at Caney, Kansas, directed by the Stumpff funeral Home & Crematory.

Mr. Bartlett preceded her in death on April 2, 1977. She was married Michael Edward McGrew on February 14, 1978, in Bartlesville. They have

made their home in Bartlesville since that time. She was a longtime member of the Bartlesville Southern Baptist Church and was a current member of the Trinity Baptist Church. She dedicated many years of volunteering her time in the church kitchens and nurseries, and was also a volunteer at the Voice of the Martyrs. She loved to go to garage sales and was a very giving and caring person, always putting herself last.
