Bobby Lee Waits, 81, died at home in Claremore, OK on January 16, 2015. He was born on February 24, 1933 to Ivan and Rosie Waits in Cameron, Oklahoma. They made their home in Ochelata, OK where they were actively involved in the Ochelata Bible Holiness Church and owned and operated Waits Garage for many years.

Bobby worked at TRW/Reda-Pump Co. in Bartlesville, OK where he retired after 37 years of employment.

He served in the United States Army from 1953-5 and remained in the Reserves until January 31, 1962.

Rosie Waits, his two brothers, Wesley and J.R. and their wives.
