Burkley McKay Hansen, 13, passed away on Saturday, April 4, 2015 due to injuries sustained from an ATV accident. He was born on November 22, 2001 in Provo, Utah to his father Clinton Burk Hansen and mother Tamara Lee (Christian) Hansen. Burk's first name came from combining his father and mother's middle names. He was the middle child between two sets of twins and he was often referred to as the "non-twin" in the family.

His first love in life was his family. He loved hanging out with all of them and going on family activities. He had a special bond with his father and looked up to him as his special hero. From childhood he had a passion for basketball. He tried other sports, but as he grew, basketball became his focus. He could be found each day outside shooting baskets. He loved to wear bright, neon colors and could almost always be seen wearing his Brigham Young University (BYU) sweatshirt. His favorite basketball player was Jimmer Fredette and that is the reason he wore the number 32 on every basketball team he played.

Burk had a passion for and a strong conviction of his faith. He planned to serve a 2 year service mission after graduating high school, but God called him home to begin his eternal mission. He served others in many ways. He

loved to help others and never wanted anyone to be sad or lonely or alone. He was quick to smile and uplift others. He was a friend to all around him. He sought out the lonely and sad and did what he could to cheer them up.

He was active in his Boy Scout troop and was only a few requirements from earning his First Class rank. He personified the scout Oath and Law through his daily actions. At church, he was serving as the president of his Deacon's quorum. He lived to serve others.

He is survived by his family including his father and mother, his brother Nathan Leon Hansen, sister Mikah Dawn Hansen, sister Elayna Faith Hansen, and brother Ethan Clint Hansen. He is also survived by his paternal grandmother, Claudia (Hansen) Johnson and her husband Hugh Johnson, of Pine Valley, UT, paternal great grandfather, Harry Orvin and his wife Barbara Orvin, of St. George, UT, and his maternal grandparents Dr. McKay and Kay Christian, of St. George, UT in addition to many cousins, aunts, uncles, and friends.

Funeral services will be held Thursday, April 9, 2015 at The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-Day Saints building located at 1501 Swan Drive in Bartlesville, OK. There will be a public viewing from 5:00-6:30 and the funeral will begin at 7:00. The burial will take place on Monday, April 13, 2015 in St. George, UT.
