Carol Frances Jolliff Lubensky, 79, went to meet her Lord on Sunday October 12, 2014 after a losing battle with Alzheimer's. Carol was born in Kansas City, Missouri on August 30, 1935 to Charles Francis Jolliff and Ruth Loretta Cox Jolliff. The oldest of two children.

Graduated from Bishop Hogan High School in 1953 and attended Central Missouri State College in Warrensburg, Missouri. Worked at Sheffield Steel in Kansas City, Missouri for five years in the accounting department. Married William Paul Lubensky on August 29, 1959 and lived in Marshall, Missouri and worked at Farmers Savings Bank while her husband finished college. Moved to Kansas City, Missouri and husband worked for Phillips Petroleum Company. In 1970 moved to Bartlesville when husband was transferred there. While in Bartlesville she volunteered at Ranch Heights grade school library for several years. Later did volunteer work at Jane Phillips Hospital for 35 years in the escort services with over 4000 hours of volunteer work. Was an active member of St. James Catholic church and was a member of the women's club. Also served as cookie chairman for the girl scouts.

Carol gave birth to two children, Michael Charles Lubensky and Deborah Kathleen Lubensky. She had 7 grandchildren and 3 Great grand children. She is survived by her husband William, two children Michael Lubensky of

Myrtle Beach, South Carolina and Deborah Miller of St. Louis, Missouri. Six grand children, Charles Lubensky of Oklahoma City, Philip Lubensky of Myrtle Beach, Caitlin Taylor of Myrtle Beach, Timothy Lubensky of Myrtle Beach, Jessica Miller of St. Louis, Brian Miller of St. Louis.
