She had been a member of the First Presbyterian Church, Phillips Synchronized Swimming Team, was an avid gardener and had been President of the Fleur De Lis Garden Club in Bartlesville and was a member of the Jane Phillips Sorority.

Charles and Jean were married in Bartlesville on June 25, 1961 and made their home in Bartlesville since that time. They had a cabin at Grand Lake and enjoyed boating, snow skiing and ballroom dancing. They were also avid travelers and had traveled all over Europe, Northern Africa, Asia and South America.
