Clifford Adrian Poe, age 84, of Bartlesville, OK passed away on Thursday, November 20, 2014. He was born on January 14, 1930 the son of the late Juanita May Close and Reuben Hadley Poe.

Clifford was a veteran of World War II who spent many years managing grocery stores, and serving as a Union official for AFL-CIO Amalgamated Meat Cutters of North America.
