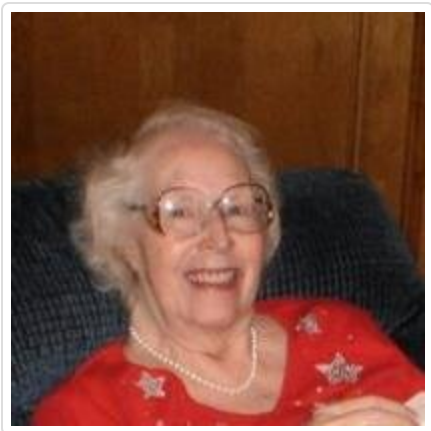




Cora LaVola LaRue

Cora LaVola LaRue, 81, former resident of Bartlesville, died Saturday December 8, 2012, in Houston, Texas.

Funeral services will be held at 10:00 AM on Thursday, December 13, 2012, in the Adams Boulevard Church of Christ with Mr. David Hammonds officiating. Interment will be in the Dewey Cemetery under the direction of the Stumpff Funeral Home & Crematory.

Mrs. LaRue was also a member of the Oklahoma Writers Guilds and produced Poetry. She was strongly dedicated to the Lord and her family.

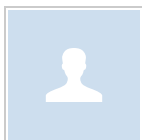
