Dean Leon Courteny age 90 passed away March 29, 2024, at Linnwood Nursing Center in Cushing Oklahoma. He was born September 14, 1933, in South English Iowa to Roscoe and Caryl Courtney. In Dean's earlier years he attended Wellman Iowa Highschool and later graduated in 1951. Right after he graduated High School he enlisted in the U.S. Navy. While in the Navy he met the love of his life Margaret "Peg" Ann Corn and they wed December 19, 1954. The two created a life they loved despite the challenges of Military life. Dean was later honorably discharged in 1956.

Dean enjoyed life as well as going fishing, gardening, and tinkering with his tractors. He was also a well-known man around the Caney, Kansas area as he dedicated 30+ years as a Postman delivering mail for United States Postal Service. He later retired in 1989.
