Dean Earl Cunningham, 71, of Bartlesville, Oklahoma passed away, Sat. May 26, 2012 at 10:32 PM in the Jane Phillips Hospital of complications following a brave fight with complications of Parkinson's Disease with his wife and daughters at this side.

Dean was born on June 18, 1940 in Salt Lake City, UT to Alvin Earl and Beulah (Schroeder) Cunningham. He spent his youth in the Murray and South Salt Lake area graduating from Granite High School.
