Deborah Kay French passed away on September 1, 2023. She was born in Bartlesville, Oklahoma to Terrel and Charlotte Taylor on June 7th, 1962. She was the third born of five children. From a young age Debbie had a love for the arts. She was always using her wit and creativity to keep her friends and family entertained. She was actively involved in choir and the newspaper throughout her high school and college years. She graduated from College High School in 1980 with many academic achievements and scholarships. Debbie chose to continue her education at Harding University where she graduated with a bachelor's degree in education. She spent her life following that calling. Debbie married James French Jr. on November 29th, 1986, in their hometown and shortly after journeyed to Zimbabwe, Africa to teach at Nhowe Mission School.
