Delores Dawn Bonham-Snider, 80, formerly of Copan, died at 8:55 P.M. on Saturday, September 23, 2017 at the North County Senior Living facility in Collinsville.

Memorial services for Mrs. Bonham-Snider will be held at 11 A.M. on Thursday, September 28, 2017 at the Copan United Methodist Church with Pastor Warren Peck officiating. Cremation arrangements were under the direction of the Stumpff Funeral Home & Crematory.

Mrs. Bonham-Snider was born at Cache, Oklahoma on October 19, 1936 the daughter of Oscar Horace Wills and Carmen Jewel (Long) Wills.
