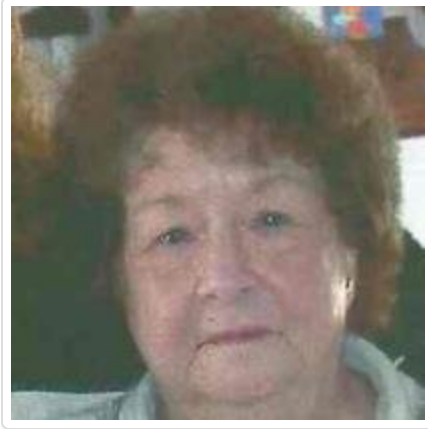




Deloris June Hawk
