He and Amy chauffeured our wedding photographer around during our out of state wedding weekend, and took her back and forth to the airport. Dennis loved cameras and photos, he even took our engagement photos for us. That segues into the third time I saw him cry, when he ordered me a portable stabilizer for my iphone. Use it and make memories of your kids he told me, with tears in his eyes. Dennis was always up for some fun, whether it was taking us on their boat and going skiing, or going spontaneously to the movies, but he wasn't sharing his popcorn—he would get you your own. A few months ago he touched my heart with thoughtfulness, calling me up this fall to offer us his airline miles so that my in-laws could possibly come visit from Romania.

Dennis was only my uncle for 14 years but I loved him dearly and felt like he had always been in the family. He will be missed. □
