Mrs. Doris Lee Hamilton, 85, of Bartlesville, died at 12:40 A.M. on Friday, August 29, 2014 at her home.

Graveside funeral services for Mrs. Hamilton will be held at 2 P.M. on Tuesday, September 2, 2014 at the Dewey Cemetery with Rev. Charles McCarthy, pastor of the Bible Church of Bartlesville officiating. Interment will be in the Dewey Cemetery directed by the Stumpff Funeral Home & Crematory.

Mrs. Hamilton was born in Bartlesville, Oklahoma on August 21, 1929 to Homer and Clara Gale (Scranton) Smith. She grew up and received her education in Bartlesville and graduated from College High School in 1947. She then attended secretarial school at Bartlesville Business College. She was employed with Phillips Petroleum Company in Bartlesville for ten years and then with Reproductive Services for five years. Mrs. Hamilton was then employed in the Accounting Department of Reda Pump Company in Bartlesville until her retirement in the mid 1990's. She was married to Bob Ray Hamilton on September 29, 1948 in Bartlesville and they have made their home in Bartlesville since that time. She was a member of the Order of Eastern Star, the First Christian Church and served as the secretary and

reporter for the College High Wildcats Class of 1947.

Mrs. Hamilton is survived by her husband, Bob Hamilton of the home, two sons, Lee Hamilton and wife Jane of Bartlesville and Ray Hamilton and wife Terry of Carrollton, Texas, one sister, Eldora Barker of Bartlesville, one brother, Bud Smith of Dewey, six grandchildren and seven great grandchildren. She was preceded in death by her parents and one sister.
