Funeral services for Elmer Floyd Brown, 91, of Skiatook, OK, were held Tuesday, July 25, 2017 at 11:00 a.m. at Peters-Stumpff Funeral Home Chapel in Skiatook with Reverend Dale Nielsen officiating. Interment in Ramona City Cemetery was under the direction of Peters-Stumpff Funeral Home. Elmer passed away on July 19, 2017 in Tulsa, Oklahoma. He was born on October 15, 1925 in Ripley, Oklahoma, to Jody Willard and Bessie Jane (Sumpter) Brown. Elmer was a graduate of Ramona High School. He served his country in the United States Navy during WWII. After his honorable discharge in 1946 he worked as a furniture salesman and a mechanic before moving to California where he retired from Pacific Bell Telephone as a Transportation Supervisor. He married Ruby Lee McQueen on June 7, 1957; she preceded him in death on February 16, 2000. Elmer and Ruby moved to the Grand Lake area after he retired; with six Cadillacs and an R.V. They moved to Skiatook in 1998. Elmer had a passion for Cadillac automobiles, often building them from the ground up. In 2012 he traveled with other veterans on the Honor Flight to Washington D.C.. Elmer is survived by two sons: Len Kramme and wife Rosemary of Bethany; Jimmy Brown of Tulsa; a niece Gayle Cook of Tulsa; three grandchildren, five great grandchildren and five great great grandchildren. He was preceded in death by his parents, his wife Ruby, a son Charles Paul Kramme, a brother Stanley Earl Brown and a sister Maymie Lynch.
