Mr. Elmer Curtis Summers, 91, of Bartlesville, died at 9:37 A.M. on Tuesday, May 10, 2011 in Bartlesville.

Funeral services for Mr. Summers will be held at 10 A.M. Monday, May 16, 2011 in the Stumpff Funeral Home Chapel with Mr. David Hammonds of the Adams Blvd. Church of Christ officiating. Interment will be in the Memorial Park Cemetery where full military rites will be accorded by the James H. Teel American Legion Post # 105. Funeral services and interment are under the direction of the Stumpff Funeral Home & Crematory.

Mr. Summers was born on July 8, 1919 at Cowlington, Oklahoma to Thomas Wesley and Grace Florence (Pruitt) Summers. He grew up and received his education in Cowlington, Oklahoma and he was married to Cleo Lucille Callahan at Stigler, Oklahoma on November 29, 1940. He entered the United States Army Air Force in February 1943 and served in the European Theatre during World War II. Following his Honorable Discharge in October 1945, Mr. and Mrs. Summers made their home at Drayton Plains, Michigan where he was employed with General Motors as an experimental mechanic until his retirement. Mr. and Mrs. Summers moved to Bartlesville to make their home in 1989 and Mrs. Summers preceded him in death on September 3, 2009. He

was a member of the Adams Blvd. Church of Christ.

Mr. Summers is survived by one brother, Arvin Summers of Huron, Tennessee, two sisters, Betty Brickner of Carson City, Nevada and Imogene Lasnear of Mesa, Arizona, and brother-in-law and sister in laws, Jeff and Geneva Callahan and Elsie Morgan all of Placerville, California and Mary Jane Shafer of Bakersfield, California.
