Mrs. Eveline Bernard, 83, of Bartlesville, died at 8:50 A.M. on Wednesday, January 14, 2015 at the Heritage Villa Nursing Center.

They made their home in Duncan, Oklahoma for two years until returning to Bartlesville to make their home in 1953. In the 1970's, Mrs. Bernard was employed for several years as a store clerk at the J.C. Penny store in Bartlesville. She was active in all of her girl's activities such as Brownies, Girl Scouts, and PTA as well as church activities. She and Mr. Bernard started Bernard Roofing in 1969 and were both active in the business until their retirement in 1991. She was also an active volunteer with Elder Care,

Homebound, Meals on Wheels and had been an active volunteer since 2000 with Voice of the Martyrs until her illness. She was a member of the First Wesleyan Church.

Mrs. Bernard is survived by three daughters, Linda Smith and husband Joe of Bartlesville, Kathy Jagers and husband Mike of Oklahoma City, and Anita Spencer and husband Ken of Bartlesville, three sisters, Edna Fox of Bartlesville, Maxine Mattox of Broken Arrow, and Imogene Schmidt of Tulsa, two brothers, Elzie Stephens of Jay and Ellis Stephens of Bartlesville, four grandchildren, Stephen Jagers of
