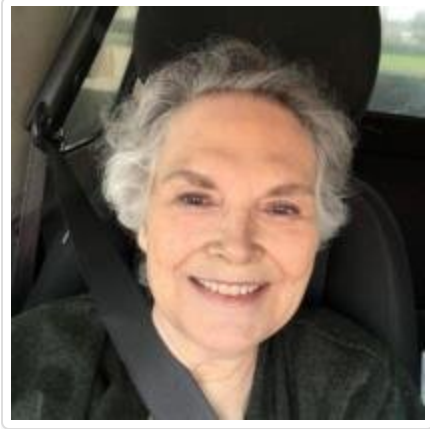




Faith Rosalie Eastman
