Mr. Glenn Edward Rigdon, 73, of Bartlesville, died at 2:55 A.M. on Thursday, December 13, 2012 at his home.

He moved to Bartlesville in 1959 and was employed with Roto-Rooter and then with Phillips Petroleum Company in 1962. He held several positions with Phillips until his retirement in March of 1993 as the line foreman at the airport. He was also a stock car racing enthusiast with which he was involved from 1966 until 1973. Mr. Rigdon was married to Phyllis Rae (Parks) Campbell on August 18, 1978

in Bartlesville and they have made their home in Bartlesville since that time. Following his retirement from Phillips he remodeled and sold houses. He was also active for a number of years in maintaining the American Legion Baseball field at the Bartlesville Municipal Stadium. He enjoyed spending time with his family especially the monthly birthday gatherings with his siblings. He was always willing to help someone fix their car or their house.
