Mrs. Helen Elizabeth Walker, 88, longtime Bartlesville resident, died at 11:05 P.M. on Tuesday, September 23, 2014 at her home in Norman, Oklahoma.

While living in Bartlesville Mrs. Walker was a member of the Adams Blvd. Church of Christ, garden club, bridge club, and a sewing club, the Jane Phillips Auxiliary and was a Girl Scout leader.

Since moving to Norman she was a member of the Alameda Church of Christ in Norman. Mr. and Mrs. Walker were active RV travelers in the United States as members of Wheels & Reels travel group and had also traveled to Europe and Asia.
