I was just informed of Henry's passing a few days ago. Gracie, Cordell, Harlene, and all of the family, my heart is broken as I was always looking forward to a time soon when Henry planned to visit us here in Belize.

Your brother was my first true love and example of a person who engaged life fully and taught me at the age of 15 that getting "high on life" had nothing to do with drugs or alcohol. His "drugs" were dancing, song and laughter...lots of laughter! He teased me so much, I would get upset, but I cherish so much those memories of how he would make light of serious situations while keeping me safe. Henry was also my first role model of a male adult who handles problems without violence or domination.

One of my most cherished memories with Henry was long after we had split as a couple and I had just left an abusive relationship in Texas. Henry got in touch at my empty apartment and helped me get furniture. We entered a dance contest and won first prize. There was a group of 6-10 year-olds (dressed in foil boxes and dancing to "Wiki Wiki") who came in second. We thought they should have won. First prize was a free evening of stretch limo services. Henry asked me what I thought if we have the kids and their sponsors go limo cruising right then, so we all piled high into this huge limo and cruised around Dallas on a Saturday afternoon, with the music blasting and the kids playing with every button and gadget inside: windows and sunroofs in constant motion. What a chaotic and beautiful experience.

To all of the family, my deepest and sincerest condolences as this world has been dealt a tragic loss with Henry's untimely passing. Heaven has received an exceptionally special soul.
