Mr. Hugh E. Rodgers, 79, retired Reda Pump Machinist of 42 years, resident of Ochelata, died at 3:10 P.M. on Monday at the Journey Home in Bartlesville. Graveside Services for Mr. Rodgers will be held at 11:00 A.M. on Saturday September 26, 2015 at the Ochelata Cemetery, with Rev. Ted Hoffman of the Ochelata United Methodist Church, and Rev.
