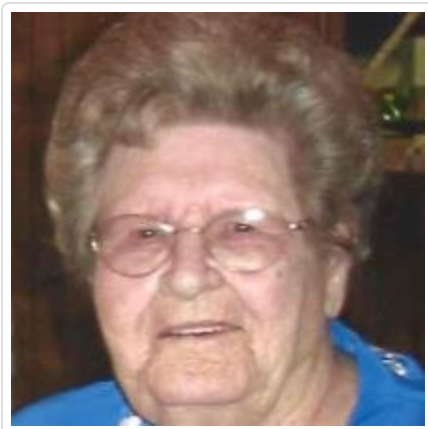




Mrs. Iris M. Steeley
