Jessalyn Elizabeth McNeill, age 85, a resident of Cassville, Mo. died Sunday April 24, 2011 in the home of Gary and Dianne McNeill, Bartlesville, OK. Jessalyn was a Barry County native and a descent of early 1800's Missouri pioneers in the Kings Prairie Community.

Jessalyn attended Ozark grade school and was a graduate of the 1943 Purdy High School graduating class. She married Thomas King McNeill son of Bee and Rilda King McNeill of rural Purdy, Mo. Tommy and Jessalyn were married May 12, 1944 in the farm home of his grandparents Henry Smith King and Susan Riddle King, rural Purdy. That farm home remains today the McNeill family farm.

Jessalyn enjoyed music, singing, and playing the piano. Her life was focused on caring for her parents and her husband Tommy. Grandchildren were a joy

to Jessalyn.

Jessalyn and Tommy spent the vast majority of their lives in Southwest Missouri. They lived in Purdy, Monett, Granby, a short 3 years in Wichita, Kansas, 12 years in Neosho, and the last 40 years in Cassville. Tommy and Jessalyn owned and operated Nifty Cleaners, Cassville from 1970 until their retirement in 1990. Both are North American Rockwell/Rocketdyne Neosho, Mo. retirees.

Jessalyn is a lifelong member of the United Methodist faith and a member of the United Methodist Church, Cassville.
