Dakotah continued his education and was an excellent student receiving a Bachelors degree in Business Administration, medical coding, and certificates in professional development in the Army, and in welding. He worked hard and was a 4.0 student.

He was a member at Humble Road Church and had a love of the outdoors. An adventurer at heart, he was an avid hunter and fisherman. He had many adventures in his all too short lifetime, which included kickboxing, bull riding, and riding his Harley. And on any given Saturday in the fall, he could be found cheering or yelling at his favorite college football team the OU Sooners.
