Jimmie Lee House, 91, of Bartlesville, OK, passed away on November 15, 2024, at the Journey Home of Bartlesville.

Born on November 1, 1933, in Nowata County, Oklahoma, Jimmie lived a full and dedicated life, primarily in Bartlesville, where he touched many hearts and earned the respect of his family, friends, and colleagues.
