JOHN RICHARD CARBONI

Mr. John Richard Carboni, 62, of Bartlesville, died Tuesday July 17th at Bartlesville, Oklahoma. There will be a Rosary Service for Mr. Carboni at 7:00 P.M. on Tuesday evening at the Stumpff Funeral Home Chapel, with Father Festus Maliwai of the St. John Catholic Church as the Celebrant, and a Funeral Mass will be held at 10:00 A.M. on Wednesday at the St. John Catholic Church. Interment will be in the Ft. Gibson National Cemetery at Ft. Gibson Oklahoma at 2:00 P.M. on Wednesday, where full Military honors will be presented by the members of the Muskogee American Legion Post #105 Honor Guard, and under the direction of the Stumpff Funeral Home & Crematory.

Mr. Carboni was a native of Ft. Wayne Indiana born March 9, 1950, at Fort Wayne to John Baptista and Rita Wanieta (Storie) Carboni. He was raised and received his education at Ft. Wayne attending Precious Blood Catholic School, and later graduating from Central Catholic School at Ft. Wayne. He enlisted in the U.S. Navy and served during the Vietnam Conflict as a medical

corpsman serving 4 years active duty and 2 years as a reserve until his honorable discharge on February 4, 1975. He was first married to Deloris Marie Ashlock on October 30, 1972, at Ft. Wayne Indiana, and they made their home at Ft. Wayne where he managed Scotts Grocery there, until moving to Bartlesville in August of 1994. He was employed here as a Grocery Manager at Wal-Mart until 1997. He was later married to Carmell Bartlett on February 13, 1997 at Norwalk California, and they made their home at La Puente California, where he was employed in retail management as a team leader for the Target Corporation until October of last year when they moved to Bartlesville. They have made their home here since October of last year. Mr. Carboni was a member of the Catholic Church, and the Bartlesville American Legion James H. Teel Post #105 , and was a dedicated family man and loved being a “Papa” to his grandchildren.

Mr. Carboni is survived by his wife Carmell (Bartlett) Carboni of the home, by Three sons, John Baptista Carboni, Christopher Richard Carboni and Gregory William Carboni all of Bartlesville, by Five daughters; Leslie Marie Carboni, of Bartlesville, Carmell Linda Taylor of Englewood Colorado, Amy Sue Henley, Rachel DeAnn Perez, and Connie Dalina Barron, all of Bartlesville, and his former wife Deloris Marie(Ashlock)Carboni, also of Bartlesville, by five brothers Tim Carboni, Gary Carboni, Jim Carboni, Tom Carboni, and Dwayne Carboni; all of Ft. Wayne Indiana, and by a sister Rita Moore Carboni, and his Mother Mrs. Rita Wanieta Carboni both of Ft. Wayne Indiana, and by eight grandchildren. He was preceded in death by his father John Baptista Carboni in 2004.
