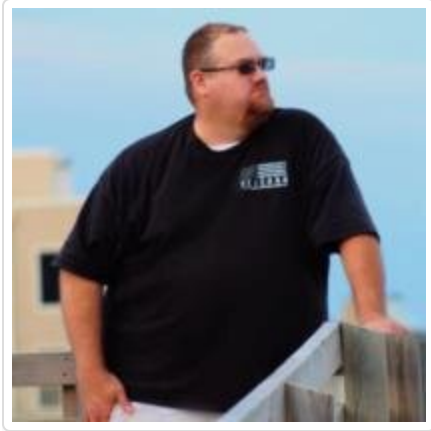




John Garland Repp

John Garland Repp passed away Friday, September 3, 2021, in Tulsa, Oklahoma at the young age of 46. John was born to Allen Ray Repp and Linda Kaye Russell Repp on November 29, 1974, in Lufkin, Texas.
