Joyce Ailene Cook, 59, resident of Claremore, former longtime Oologah resident, died at 11:30 P.M. on Saturday at the Hillcrest Medical Center in Tulsa.

Funeral Services for Mrs. Cook will be held at 1:00 P.M. Saturday, June 1, 2013 at the Eastern Hills Baptist Church in Claremore, with Pastor Phil Tallman officiating, and interment will be in the Memorial Park Cemetery in Nowata under the direction of the Stumpff Funeral Home & Crematory of Bartlesville.
