Mr. Lester E. "Les" Hudgens, 76, of Bartlesville, died at 12:55 A.M. on Thursday, March 26, 2015 at the Jane Phillips Medical Center following a brief illness.

Funeral services will be held at 10 A.M. on Saturday in the Stumpff Funeral Home Chapel with Pastor Jerry Schenk of Ochelata officiating. Interment will be in Anderson, Missouri.

Mr. Hudgens was born in Noel, Missouri on April 28, 1938 the son of Joseph Ernest Hudgens and Grace F. (Ragsdale) Hudgens. He grew up in McDonald County, Missouri in the Anderson area. He came to the Bartlesville/Dewey area in 1955 and was employed in various service stations, at Reda Pump and at B & B Freight Line. He was then employed with the U.S. Post Service as a MVS truck driver until his retirement at the age of 74. He had also been active as an independent oil producer since the 1980's. He served with the Army National Guard from 1954 until his Honorable Discharge as a Staff Sergeant in September of 1962. He was a member of the Fraternal Order of Eagles, was a member of the Bartlesville Masonic Lodge, was a 32nd degree Mason, a member of the Tulsa Scottish Rite and the Akdar Shrine. He was also a member of the Caney Valley Antique Power Association Old Tractors Club and enjoyed collecting and working on old cars and attending car shows. He was married to Shirley Ann Barnard on June 26, 1986 in Miami, Oklahoma and they have made their home in Bartlesville. He lived a good life and

enjoyed his family and friends.

Survivors include his wife Shirley, one son, Mike Hudgens and wife Tammy of Dewey, a step son, Rodney Jenkins and wife Jean of Tulsa, step daughters, Debbie Brewer and husband Steven of Ochelata and Diana Martin of Broken Arrow, one sister, Naydean Mock of Colorado Springs, Colorado, one grandson, Trevor Hudgens of Dewey, several step grandchildren and numerous nieces nephews and cousins. He was preceded in death by his parents, two brothers and four sisters.
