Lillie Mae (Walton) Flemons, at the age of 90 years old, went to her Heavenly Home on November 7, 2021. She accepted the Lord as her Savior at an early age, and enjoyed attending church services at Victory Worship Center in Bartlesville, Oklahoma.

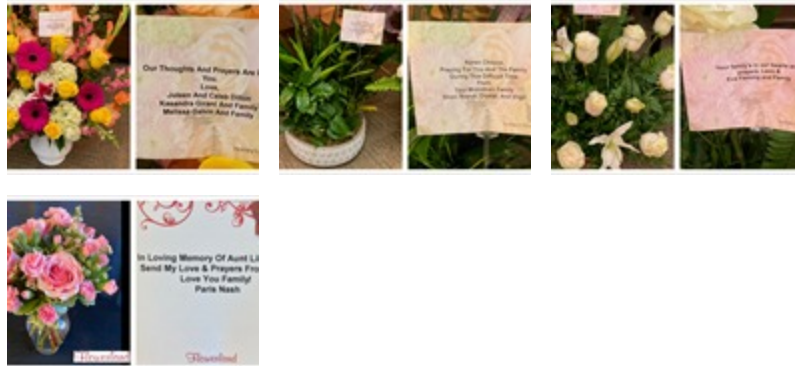

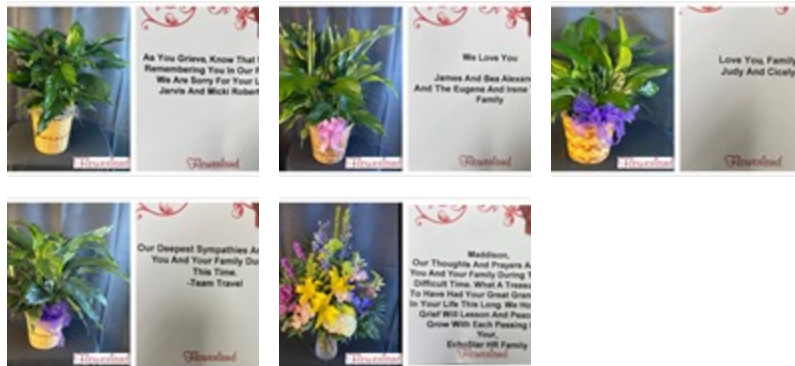
