Linda Marie (Chandler) Hosey was born on July 9, 1959 in Roswell, NM. Her father was Bill Chandler and her mother is Shelley Chandler. She was the middle of 3 children. Linda lived in Roswell until 1966 while her father worked at Mobile Oil, then the family moved to Midland, Texas and finally to Houston, Texas. As was their custom, the family deeply involved in one of the Nazarene churches.

Linda graduated from Sharpstown High School in Houston, Texas in 1977 and began attending Bethany Nazarene College in Oklahoma as a business computer science major. It was there she met a ministry major named Russell Hosey.

Linda and Russell were married on June 19, 1982 in Houston, Tx. In 1986, Linda and Russell moved to Tahlequah, Ok, where they not only pastored their first church, but got their first child: Jeffrey.
