Linda Jo (Trottingwolf) Leach, 69, of Bartlesville, surrounded by her loving family, went to her heavenly home at 1:28 a.m. on Wednesday, November 20, 2019 at the St. John Medical Center in Tulsa.

Mrs. Leach was born in Bartlesville on August 6, 1950 the daughter of Edwin Lincoln Trottingwolf and Florence Rachel (Scullaw) Trottingwolf. She grew up and received her education in the Ochelata area and graduated from Ochelata High School in 1968. She had been employed at Kenny's Café in Bartlesville, Woolworth's and she cleaned houses. 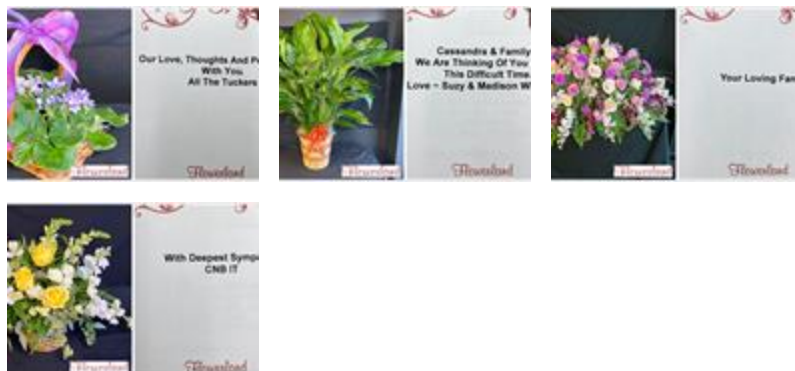

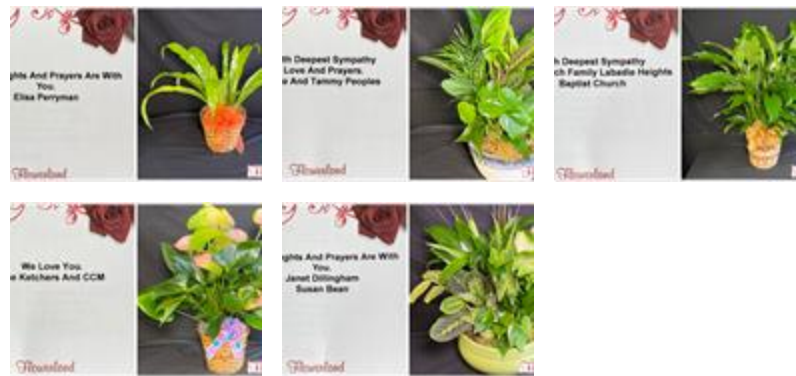

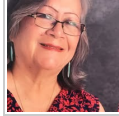
