Loren Leon Pollard Jr, 16, student died Tuesday, October 29 in Bartlesville.

Memorial Services will be held at 2:00 P.M. on Friday November 1st 2013 at the Victory Church, with Rev. Timothy Kutz, pastor of Victory Church officiating. Cremation arrangements are under the direction of the Stumpff Funeral Home & Crematory.

He has also been active in Boy Scouts, had attended Victory Church and Life Church in Bartlesville, and First Christian Church in Dewey, where he was active in the youth group.

Terrell of the home, three brothers; Jonathon Hale, Christopher Hale, and Michael Hale, all of Bartlesville, and a sister Sarah Johnson, of the home, by a Aunt; Teresa Meyer of Chugiak, Alaska, and Preston Neill, and by his grandparents Carolyn and Glen Neill of Shidler, Oklahoma, and many others too numerous to mention here. He was preceded in death by his grandparents, Virginia and Benny Thomason, and by his great grandmother Marine Condo.
