After retiring from KT (34 years) she went to work for Dr. Mark Stoskopf DDS

as office manager in El Dorado, Kansas. She retired in late 1998 and moved to Bartlesville, OK in January 1999. Margie was active in the First Baptist Church senior programs and loved to travel.

Mrs. Swigart is survived by one son, Ron Swigart and wife Jan of Bartlesville, a granddaughter, Patty Beets and husband Bob of Bartlesville, a great granddaughter, Taylor Beets of OSU at Stillwater, and numerous nieces and nephews.
