



Marguerite Leona Eastin

March 10, 1925 - March 25, 2022

Marguerite Eastin, known to friends as Marge, was received into heaven on March 25, 2022, only a few weeks shy of her 97th birthday. She was preceded by her husband Benjamin Harrison Eastin, Jr. who passed away in 1986, and her siblings Blanche Estelle Sumpter, Dorothy Grace Lair, Dora Ethel Owens, George Ashley Hawkins, Charley Lewis Hawkins, Jr., Mary Elizabeth Hopkins, Audrey Lucille Sears, Robert Lawrence Hawkins, and Lora Marie Hawkins.

Marge was born on April 10, 1925, in Oglesby, Oklahoma, the ninth child of Charley Lewis and Grace Olive Hawkins. She grew up helping on the family farm there and attending school in Ramona, where she also graduated high school. In 1942 she married Ben who volunteered shortly thereafter for the U.S. Army as the nation plunged into World War II. In 1943, shortly before Ben's unit was scheduled to depart for England, Marge gave birth to their son Dennis Lloyd Eastin. Their second child, Shannon Kay Eastin, was born in 1947 following Ben's return from service.

Together, Marge and Ben operated a farm in Ramona, first raising dairy cows and then beef. In 1962 Marge graduated from Bartlesville Business College and later was hired by the Coca Cola Bottling Company in Bartlesville, where she worked for 25 years. Marge was a faithful member of New Harmony Baptist Church where she sang in the choir and taught children's Sunday school classes for many years. Pastor Tom Cox, who will officiate her funeral,

said she was one of the finest Christians he had ever known.

Marge is survived by her children Dennis and Shannon, her brother William “Bill” Leo Hawkins, four grandchildren, and six great-grandchildren.

A funeral service will be held Tuesday, March 29, at 10am at Stumpff Funeral Home Chapel and is under the direction of Stumpff Funeral Home and Crematory.

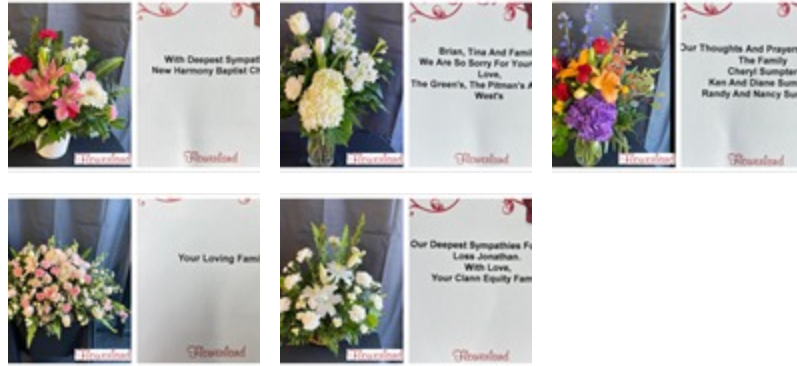
