She met John Francis "Jack" Leuck in Kansas City, MO and they married on Sept 3 1955. They moved to Bartlesville Ok in 1966 where Jack worked for Phillips Petroleum. Mary began working as a legal secretary for Rowland and Rowland in 1973 and was there until she retired in 1988.

Mary was a generous and kind hearted woman who spent much of her life giving back to the community. She volunteered at the Jane Phillips Hospital Auxiliary, the Literacy Council, and was the volunteer librarian for St John's School for several years. An active member of St John's Catholic Church, she was a member of the choir as well as singing with the Bartlesville Choral society.
