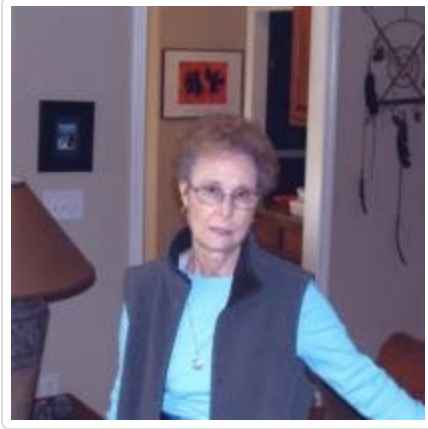




Mattie Mae Hauser
