Mr. Michael T. Verdin, 74, of Bartlesville, died Friday, February 14, 2014. Graveside services will be held at 10:30 A.M. Wednesday, February 19, 2014 at the White Rose Cemetery with Father Archie Fernandez of the St. James Catholic Church officiating. Full military rites will be accorded by the Ceremonial Detail of the James H. Teel American Legion Post # 105 and funeral arrangements are under the direction of the Stumpff Funeral Home & Crematory.

In lieu of flowers a memorial has been established to the St. John Catholic School, 121 West 8th Street, Bartlesville, Oklahoma, 74003.

Mr. Verdin was born at Independence, Kansas on August 22, 1939 the son of Jacinto and Aurora (Ruiz) Verdin. He grew up and received his education in Chanute, Kansas and graduated from high school there in 1957. He later attended the University of Tulsa where he received a Bachelor's Degree in Business Administration with a Major in accounting. He was married to Elizabeth A. Perez on July 5, 1958 at Miami, Oklahoma. Mr. Verdin served in the U.S. Air Force from September 19, 1957 until receiving his Honorable Discharge on May 29, 1962. He and Mrs. Verdin came to Bartlesville to make their home and he was employed with Central States Investments and then Phillips Petroleum Company where he retired as an accountant. He was a member of the St. John Catholic Church, the Eagle's Lodge and had been an active volunteer for the Mary Martha Mission.

Survivors include his wife, Elizabeth Verdin of Bartlesville, two sons, Michael A. Verdin and wife Char of Flower Mound, Texas, and Steven M. Verdin of Bartlesville, five grandchildren and one great granddaughter. He was preceded in death by his parents and a grandson, Steven Tyler Verdin.
