Mr. Morgan Locke Jones, 73, of Bartlesville, died at 9:43 P.M. on Tuesday, February 18, 2014 in Bartlesville.

He began his career with Phillips Petroleum Company in 1973 and worked in England, Norway, Denver, Colorado, Borger, Texas, Houston, Texas and Bartlesville, Oklahoma at his retirement Mr. Jones was the World Wide Drilling Manager for Phillips Petroleum Company. Mr. Jones was a member of the First Baptist

Church in Bartlesville and after retirement worked as a consultant for OGCI in Tulsa.
