Nancy Green Worten, 88, of Bartlesville, died at 1:45 A.M. on Sunday, September 25, 2011 in Bartlesville.

Nancy Green Worten was born February 11, 1923. Her parents were Frederick Webb and Norissa Partridge Green of Guthrie, Oklahoma.

She received her education in Guthrie schools and was graduated from Guthrie High School in 1940. She attended Benedictine Heights College, Colorado Women's College and Denver University where she was a Gamma Phi Beta. She received a degree in Medical Technology (A.S.C.P.) following an internship at St. Luke's Hospital, Kansas City, Missouri.

Nancy Green and Jesse J. Worten Jr. were married on February 5, 1948 in Guthrie and made their home in Pawhuska, Oklahoma, before moving to Bartlesville in 1959 where she lived until the time of her death.
