Mrs. Naomi Mae Long, 84, of Ramona, died at 6:36 P.M. on Friday, April 25, 2014 at the St. John Medical Center in Tulsa.

Mr. Long preceded her in

death on December 25, 1989 and she has continued her home in the Ramona area since that time. She was a member of the Friends Church at Ramona .
