Orville Lee Myers, Jr. passed away July 4, 2015 at the age of 84. He was born November 23, 1930 in Bartlesville to Orville and Gale Myers. He attended Bartlesville schools and graduated from College High in 1948. Orville married his wife of 63 years, Nadean (Patterson) in 1952. He attended Oklahoma A & M and graduated in 1954. He loved his country and proudly served in the US Air Force in Tripoli, Africa.

Orville returned to Bartlesville where he built a successful career as a building contractor. He was a member of the Homebuilders Association and the Real Estate Board, and served as President in both organizations.
