Patty Cobb, 80, retired elementary school teacher and counselor, passed away peacefully Sunday, June 12, 2016 surrounded by family.

On June 27, 1958 Patty married Don Cobb at the First Baptist Church in Dewey. Don passed away on July 2, 1971.

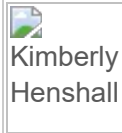
